1 CHECK THE OBVIOUS STUFF FIRST

Takes 10 seconds.
Saves 10 minutes.



- ✓ Guitar volume up?
- ✓ Guitar plugged in all the way?
- ✓ Active pickup battery good?
- ✓ Pedals powered?
- ✓ Tuner muted?
- ✓ Volume pedal up?
- ✓ Cables connected firmly?

Simple things
cause big
problems. 😊

2 BYPASS THE ENTIRE PEDALBOARD

Plug your guitar
DIRECTLY into the DI.



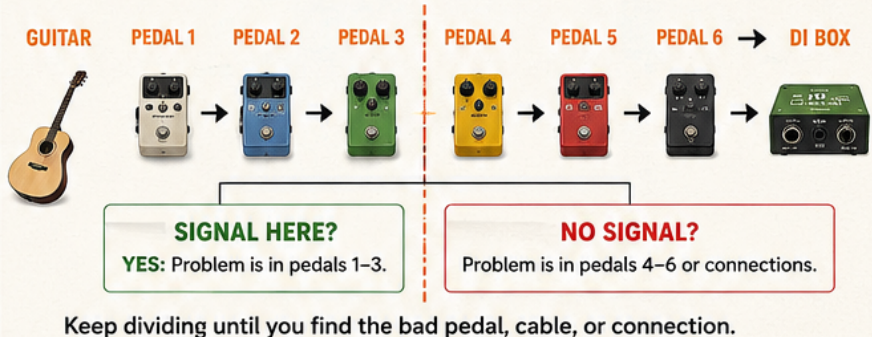
3 IF STILL NO SIGNAL, CHECK THE SHORT PATH (DOWNSTREAM)

Test each piece.
Swap if needed.



4 IF THE PEDALBOARD IS THE PROBLEM, DIVIDE IT

Start in the middle.
Test half at a time.
Keep narrowing it down.



Keep dividing until you find the bad pedal, cable, or connection.

5 CHECK THE PATCH CABLES TOO

Bad cables are more
common than
bad pedals.



Every cable is a potential failure point.



THE GOAL: **ELIMINATE POSSIBILITIES.**
FIND WHERE THE SIGNAL STOPS.
